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| Acharacle Community Company       | Highland             | £45,015  | This group will purchase the Acharacle Community Centre which provides key services to, and a meeting place for the village and the wider west Lochaber area. Community ownership of the centre will allow the company to invest in upgrading and enhancing the facility to offer improved services.                            |
| Action Party                      | Edinburgh            | £647,500 | The group will purchase the former Portobello Old Parish Church and Halls situated on Bellfield Road, Edinburgh under the Land Reform (Scotland) Act 2003). This will bring a previously well-used local amenity into community ownership and create the opportunity for it to be developed into a multi-purpose community hub. |
| Active Communities (Scotland) Ltd | Renfrewshire         | £199,000 | This group will purchase the former police station situated in the town centre of Johnstone, Renfrewshire to develop a community led health and wellbeing hub and help them consolidate their services and activities into a central space.   |
| A Heart for Duns                  | Scottish Borders     | £206,000 | The group will purchase the Volunteer Hall in Duns town centre on behalf of the community. This will empower local people to be involved in its future development and management.  |

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| All Roads Lead to Whithorn      | Dumfries and Galloway | £110,635 | This group will purchase the former Grapes Hotel in Whithorn, Dumfries and Galloway to convert it to affordable housing which will be let out.  |
| Am Fasgadh Regeneration Company | Highland              | £85,500  | This group will purchase the Old Telephone Exchange in Kingussie, a store of the former Highland Folk Museum, to provide space for a bike hub social enterprise, community events, meeting room, office and galley kitchen.               |
| Annan Harbour Action Group      | Dumfries and Galloway | £98,890  | This group will acquire a historic two-storey quayside warehouse closest to the harbour and quay along with an abandoned spit of land opposite the harbour called Ministers Merse. The project will develop the Harbour as a visitor hub. |
| Applecross Community Company    | Highland              | £11,900  | This group will purchase part of the garden of Applecross Surgery from NHS Highland and develop three two-bedroom properties for affordable housing aimed to support older people in the community.                                       |
| Applecross Community Company    | Highland              | £137,252 | The award will allow Applecross Community Company to purchase, restock and improve Togarve Community Woods and provide access for the community.  |
| Applecross Community Company    | Highland              | £151,500 | With this award Applecross Community Company will buy land in order to build nine homes for affordable rent and four for sale with rural housing burden, along with space for an electric charging point and allotments.                  |
| Ardchattan Centre               | Argyll and Bute       | £152,000 | This group will purchase the former Ardchattan Primary School and adjoining schoolhouse in order to create a community space.   |
| Ardnamurchan Lighthouse Trust   | Highland              | £224,900 | The Trust will acquire and redevelop land and buildings surrounding the iconic lighthouse to allow it to develop the cafe, shop, exhibition space and holiday lets that it already operates on the site.                                  |
| Arisaig Community Trust         | Highland              | £234,400 | This group will buy land on which to build six affordable homes and provide four discounted self-build plots, as well as providing an area for business units and a community woodland.   |

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| Arisaig Community Trust                  | Highland       | £23,750  | This group will buy 2.38 acres of land split between the shorefront and the village playground, with plans to create seating areas, car parking and interpretation boards for visitors, as well as reinforcing the sea wall and providing space for an orchard and allotments.  |
| Arkaig Community Forest SCIO             | Highland       | £36,088  | This group will purchase an area of woodland, including Clunes Forest School, in order to create opportunities for conservation, recreation and outdoor education.  |
| Assynt Development Trust                 | Highland       | £65,750  | This group will purchase 55 acres of land in Lochinver which will have multiple uses. Phase 1 aims to deliver affordable housing for rent, self-build plots, 2 commercial units/workshops, all abilities tracks and trails, and motorhome pitches.  |
| Bannockburn House Trust                  | Stirling       | £648,300 | The group will purchase the historic Bannockburn House and associated grounds extending to 25 acres situated just outside the small town of Bannockburn, Stirlingshire. This will secure the house to provide a focal point for the community and a base for new employment and volunteering opportunities, as well as community events and activities. |
| Barmulloch Community Development Co.     | Glasgow        | £88,000  | The group will purchase the former Barmulloch Church of Scotland in Barmulloch, Glasgow, which it currently leases. They plan in the longer term is to refurbish the building to create more space for community activities and to provide training and employment opportunities.   |
| Barrhill Development Trust               | South Ayrshire | £135,000 | Purchasing the village pub, The Trout Inn, will allow Barrhill Development Trust to retain an important amenity and to develop it for the benefit of the local economy and community.   |
| Barmulloch Community Development Company | Glasgow        | £85,000  | The group will purchase the former All Saints Church and church house, known locally as the Broomfield Road Centre. The centre currently houses a popular boxing gym, Money Advice Centre and training/meeting rooms, all of which will continue to flourish when the premises are brought into community ownership.                                    |

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| Black Bull Gartmore Hub and Pub         | Stirling          | £217,500 | This group will acquire the Black Bull Hotel premises and run it as a community owned and managed hub, café, pub, restaurant and accommodation facility, protecting this last remaining informal social space in the village from closure.  |
| Blackhall Community Trust               | Edinburgh         | £33,750  | This group will purchase a former sports pavilion, currently used as a nursery, in order to provide community facilities alongside the nursery. Planned improvements include a community meeting space, sports changing facilities and activities for older people.   |
| Blackwood Estate Community Association  | South Lanarkshire | £67,000  | This group will purchase Loch Wood in Blackwood Estate to safeguard it for the future and to improve access for residents of the nearby villages of Blackwood, Kirkmuirhill and Boghead.  |
| Blairgowrie & Rattray Development Trust | Perth and Kinross | £36,717  | The money will allow Blairgowrie & Rattray Development Trust to buy Mount Ericht, a former walled garden, and develop it into a community garden.   |
| Blairmore Village Hall Trust CIC        | Argyll & Bute     | £15,750  | The group will purchase a small plot of land adjoining Blairmore Village Green and Hall to provide a recreational green space and sustainable tourism hub.  |
| Boarhills and Dunino Community Trust    | Fife              | £146,340 | The group will purchase the site of a derelict yard and doocot on the edge of Boarhills village in Fife. They intend to develop it to create a green space for the community with an orchard, seating, play area, hedging, wildflowers and to restore the 17th Century doocot.  |
| Bonnymuir Green Community Trust         | Aberdeen City     | £164,750 | The group will purchase the former Bonnymuir Bowling Green, and the accompanying pavilion building, using the Community Right to Buy . It plans to create a unique external green space within the city including a market garden and a community building with a café, meeting space and retail space for locally grown produce. |
| Braemar Community Ltd                   | Aberdeenshire     | £41,025  | This group will purchase woodland and an area of community land in the village in order to provide local access to green space.   |

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| Branchton Community Centre Association   | Inverclyde        | £120,148 | The group will purchase the Branchton Community Centre including the building and associated land, car park, sports area, play area and Multi-Use Games Area. They plan to provide a refurbished play area, a community café, vocational classes, health, fitness and diet activities, youth initiatives, community development work and employability initiatives. |
| Bruntsfield St. Oswalds Ltd              | Edinburgh         | £214,713 | This group will purchase the St Oswald's church and hall in Edinburgh and develop them into a community facility, primarily focused on wraparound childcare, but with the capacity to also serve as a hub and meeting place for the community.  |
| Caberfeidh Horizons                      | Highland          | £185,339 | The group will purchase a former police station in Kingussie in Badenoch and Strathspey to adapt the building for a charity shop, community space and multi-functional accommodation facility.  |
| Cairndow Community Childcare Ltd         | Argyll & Bute     | £37,000  | The group will purchase 0.7 acres of a former coniferous plantation near Loch Fyne, Clachan, Argyll. They plan to develop the site for a new-build childcare facility and community resource centre.  |
| Cambusbarron Community Development Trust | Stirling          | £425,750 | The group will purchase the woodland areas of The Gillies Hill to develop it for people now, and future generations, to enjoy.  |
| Carbost Community Shop                   | Highlands         | £177,500 | The group will buy their local shop, which sits close to both the Talisker distillery and to the Fairy Pools, a renowned natural attraction.  |
| Carloway Community Association           | Eilean Siar       | £74,758  | The group will purchase the former Carloway Primary School and associated land situated at Knock, Carloway. The grant will also be used to help develop the building as a Rural Life Centre including a community shop, ATM and post office, as well as a space for new enterprises to grow.  |
| Carluk Development Trust                 | South Lanarkshire | £278,000 | The group will bring into community ownership the High Mill site next to Carluk town centre. The site includes the A-listed High Mill, which is the most complete windmill of its type in existence in Scotland, and a former market garden extending to 1.2 acres.   |

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| Carradale Community Trust               | Argyll & Bute       | £89,750  | This group will purchase Paterson's Bakery and Stores in the village, which has been closed since 2018, and re-open it as a retail, social and information hub.   |
| Carradale Community Trust               | Argyll & Bute       | £13,960  | This group will purchase 4.75 acres of woodland from Forest Enterprise Scotland in order to create a garden waste recycling facility for the village and to provide access to walks and wider woodland in the area.   |
| Carsphairn Community Woodland           | Dumfries & Galloway | £209,000 | This group will buy 120 acres of Muirdrochwood Forest in order to deliver long term benefits to the community including employment, recreation, education and training.   |
| Castle Loch Lochmaben Community Trust   | Dumfries & Galloway | £54,000  | This group will purchase 21 acres of woodland adjoining the grounds of the community-owned Castle Loch in to improve access to the loch and create new volunteering opportunities in woodland restoration and management.   |
| Clachan Village Hall (Kintyre) SCIO     | Argyll & Bute       | £168,888 | This group will acquire the former Kilcalmonell Free Church from private owners, providing a replacement village hall. Community ownership will enable a new facility to be established, providing an extended range of services and facilities for the local community and for visitors to the area. |
| Cliftonville & Coatdyke Community Group | North Lanarkshire   | £190,690 | This group will purchase Coatbridge Indoor Bowling Stadium in order to renovate and extend it in order to better meet the needs of the community  |
| Colinton Village Enterprise SCIO        | Edinburgh           | £47,898  | This group will purchase a former coach house from City of Edinburgh Council. "The Shed", located in Spylaw Park, will be developed to provide a community hub, arts venue and visitor centre.  |
| Colonsay Community Development Company  | Argyll and Bute     | £214,000 | This group will purchase the Baptiste Manse situated in Upper Kilchattan on the Isle of Colonsay. The property will be developed to meet the current need for short-term temporary accommodation for families and key workers on the island.  |

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| Colonsay Community Development Company                   | Argyll and Bute  | £390,000 | The group will buy two areas of land around the settlement of Scalasaig as part of a project to build homes for island residents.  |
| Comann Eachdraidh Eirsgeidh (Eriskay Historical Society) | Eilean Siar      | £48,234  | The group will buy a disused school and adjacent buildings to create a heritage exhibition space, offices, a tearoom and to renovate the former schoolhouse as a home for rent.  |
| Comann Eachdraidh Uibhist A Tuath                        | Eilean Siar      | £100,586 | The group will purchase the Old Carinish School and adjoining School House in North Uist to relocate their important Collections from the island of Benbecula, to make these accessible and to become an active community hub for the Gaelic Language, for learning, family history and the welcoming of visitors.         |
| Community Carrot Limited                                 | East Lothian     | £119,200 | This group will purchase a greengrocer's in order to strengthen its connections with local producers and increase its involvement with community groups including food banks and schools. The shop will also be used as a hub for activities such as Zero Waste Dunbar.  |
| Community Development Co. Nesting                        | Shetland Islands | £47,109  | The group will purchase a former primary school, the Aald Skul and immediate surrounding area and wooden huts, in Vassa, South Nesting.  |
| Community One Stop Shop                                  | Edinburgh        | £73,000  | This group will purchase a shop in the Broomhouse and Sighthill area of Saughton, Edinburgh, which is currently leases. COSS currently lease the property providing a range of support services.   |
| Connect Community Trust Ltd                              | Glasgow          | £114,732 | This group will purchase HubSports from Glasgow City Council (City Property) to unlock the potential of the building which CCT has been leasing for the past 12 years. Ownership will secure the future of this community facility.  |
| Copperworks Housing Association Ltd                      | Glasgow          | £419,000 | The group will purchase a vacant open space at Millburn Street, Royston, Glasgow, locally known as the Triangle site and develop it as an open green space for leisure, recreation and play to complement the wider social housing and regeneration strategies being undertaken to improve the quality of life in Royston. |

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| Cornerstone House Centre Ltd   | North Lanarkshire | £245,000 | The group will purchase a building in the town centre of Cumbernauld where they will continue to deliver existing activities including renting rooms to third sector and other organisations, delivering projects and supporting the onsite facilities.  |
| Crail Community Partnership    | Fife              | £41,500  | This group will acquire the Crail Community Hall and provide a range of activities for all ages aiming to reduce social isolation through community cohesion.  |
| Crossroads Community Hub       | East Ayrshire     | £30,517  | The group will purchase the vacant site of the former Primary School at Crossroads, East Ayrshire, to develop a new community hub. This will incorporate a community-led farm shop, coffee shop with teaching kitchen meeting/workshop space and a social/learning hub.  |
| Dalavich Improvement Group     | Argyll & Bute     | £31,080  | The group will purchase four fields in the local area, Mill Field, Homestead Field, Druimdarroch Field and Church field from the Forestry Commission Scotland. They will implement a long term strategy to improve the landscape of the village, provide grazing, a community garden project locally grown fresh fruit and vegetables. |
| Deveron Projects Ltd           | Aberdeenshire     | £270,000 | This group will purchase an empty retail building in the main square of Huntly, Aberdeenshire in order to provide more space for its community activities.   |
| Donside Village Community SCIO | Aberdeen City     | £55,100  | The group will purchase 4.5 acres of land in Tillydrone, Aberdeen, by the River Don, which is currently used by the local community for a range of leisure activities. Once in community ownership, they will improve and develop the area while also encouraging volunteering and training opportunities.                             |



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| Dornoch Area Community Interest Company          | Highland              | £405,903 | DACIC will use the award to purchase the local police station and associated land in the town's Argyle Street to create a business hub, gym, workshop space for artists and accommodation for seasonal workers.   |
| Dornoch Area Community Interest Company          | Highland              | £216,411 | This group will purchase the former Abattoir Site in the heart of Dornoch in order to establish several community facilities, including a multipurpose community centre with incorporated curling facility, car/coach parking, Multi-Use Games Area (MUGA), and a golf driving range. |
| Douglas St Bride's Community Group               | South Lanarkshire     | £141,350 | The group will purchase a building in the village of Douglas, South Lanarkshire, part of which the group lease for their charity shop which provides a useful source of income to support the operation of the St Brides Community Centre.  |
| Drongan, Rankinston and Stair Regeneration Group | East Ayrshire         | £55,000  | This group will purchase Hannahston Woods from the current estate owners to provide a local amenity and woodland area for the Drongan community.  |
| Dronley Community Woodland                       | Angus                 | £394,000 | The group will purchase 50ha of land within the boundary of Dronley Wood in Angus through the Forest Enterprise Community Asset Transfer Scheme. The project will employ a new part-time woodland manager to support and deliver the woodland management plan.                        |
| Dumfries High Street Ltd                         | Dumfries and Galloway | £178,200 | This group will acquire the buildings at 111 & 121 High Street in the town centre of Dumfries, then refurbish the space as affordable enterprise space at street level and affordable homes on the upper floors.  |
| Dunbog Community Hall                            | Fife                  | £31,500  | The group will purchase two acres of land adjacent to the community hall, next to Dunbog Primary School, which will be used to bring generations together to enjoy a range of fun and healthy activities.   |
| Dunlop Community Hub Ltd                         | East Ayrshire         | £160,000 | The group will purchase the only remaining Public House in the village and develop the upper floor to create a new, flexible space for community activities and events.   |

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| Dunnet Forestry Trust               | Highlands     | £45,950  | This group will purchase 260 acres of Dunnet Forest to develop a community amenity for the Dunnet area.   |
| Dunshalt Community Shop Ltd         | Fife          | £97,500  | The group will purchase the former Dunshalt Village Shop and Post Office in Fife, which closed in May 2016. The shop was the only one in the village and its closure has resulted in villagers having to make a 5 mile round trip to purchase basic groceries. DCS will refurbish the premises and improve the range of goods and services available. |
| Earlsferry Town Hall Ltd            | Fife          | £42,500  | This group will purchase Earlsferry Town Hall and operate it as a community hub. Community ownership will allow this important listed building to be retained for community use.  |
| East Loch Lomond Community Trust    | Stirling      | £159,600 | The group will purchase land to develop four community owned homes as part of a wider development of twenty. The facilities will be managed by Rural Stirling Housing Association and will contribute to the local economy by providing key workers housing and stabilising local businesses.   |
| Easthall Residents Association      | Glasgow       | £65,800  | The group will purchase two neglected and derelict areas of land in Easterhouse to create two areas that will provide leisure facilities for outdoor activities including; tennis courts, seven a side football pitch, running track, bike track, adventure play area and outdoor gym.  |
| EATS Rosyth                         | Fife          | £284,500 | This group will use the funding to purchase and relocate to the town's former Clydesdale Bank building in order to provide a range of new activities on cooking and food.   |
| Edinbane Community Company          | Highland      | £81,500  | Edinbane Community Company (ECC) wish to purchase the former Edinbane Shop in Edinbane, Isle of Skye, to redevelop for a range of uses and services of benefit to the community.  |
| Eilean Easdale                      | Argyll & Bute | £15,730  | The group will purchase a local dormant quarry on Easdale island, south of Oban, where the World Stone Skimming Championships take place. Owning this asset will make the championships more secure to the benefit of locals, visitors and businesses.  |
| Enzie Crossroads Community Woodland | Moray         | £17,480  | The group will purchase the Longhill Wood near Portgordon through the National Forest Land Scheme.  |

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| Etterick & Yarrow<br>Community Development<br>Company | Scottish Borders | £285,000 | By developing a disused steading this group will provide five affordable homes for rent to tackle a lack of housing in the local area. The plans also include office space and workshops for businesses  |
| Eyemouth & District<br>Community Trust                | Scottish Borders | £82,500  | The group will purchase and redevelop the vacant Burgh Chambers and adjoining Town Hall to create a 'Social Eco Innovation Centre'. The centre will provide a learning and training space, a social enterprise training kitchen, an IT resource centre, office space and space community activity. |
| Fittie Community<br>Development Trust                 | Aberdeen City    | £53,000  | The group will purchase the former Gospel Hall in Footdee, Aberdeen, which will be revived to create a thriving community owned facility.  |
| Forres Area Community<br>Trust                        | Moray            | £116,365 | This group will purchase its current home of Forres Town Hall in order to provide community facilities, meeting rooms, study and workshop areas, training facilities and co-working hot desks.   |
| Fort Augustus &<br>Glenmoriston Comm. Co.             | Highland         | £202,000 | The group will purchase a piece of open land and deciduous woodland situated in the centre of the village of Fort Augustus, following a successful community right to buy decision. They plan to manage the woodland by retaining the broadleaf trees to create a woodland amenity with walks.     |
| Fort Augustus &<br>Glenmoriston Community<br>Company  | Highland         | £98,724  | The group will purchase the site before going onto develop a new, larger medical centre that will house the local General Practitioners and a range of complementary medical and health based services for local people.   |
| Friends of Dundonald Castle                           | South Ayrshire   | £29,000  | This group will purchase the existing Dundonald Castle Visitor Centre to continue running the visitor centre for the castle and to support local community activities in the existing space.   |
| Friends of Glenan Wood                                | Argyll & Bute    | £326,750 | Friends of Glenan Wood will purchase 361 acres of woodland in Cowal and the Trossachs, developing community access, creating employment for a part-time forest ranger and a development officer, and introducing a woodland management plan to safeguard the natural ecology.                      |

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| Friends of Leadburn Community Woodland | Midlothian        | £41,000   | The group will purchase 23 acres of woodland in Midlothian from Forestry Enterprise Scotland. The woodland adjoins the group's existing community owned woodland near the village of Leadburn and, once in community ownership, will allow it to improve access to the site, develop new paths and expand the range of local volunteering activities. |
| Furnace Community SCIO                 | Argyll & Bute     | £164,065  | This group will purchase the village shop in Furnace, Argyll, and the adjacent bungalow, in order to maintain essential shop and post office services in this rural community.  |
| Garbh Allt Community Initiative        | Highland          | £273,025  | The group will purchase the West Helmsdale Crofting Estate near the village of Helmsdale in East Sutherland. Ownership will empower the community to lead and control the future development of the Estate.   |
| Garioch Heritage Society               | Aberdenshire      | £ 466,000 | This group will acquire the building of Garioch Heritage Centre which currently holds collections and exhibitions, preserving and disseminating information about the social, cultural, natural and economic history of the Garioch to local people and visitors. Ownership will secure this well used asset for the community.                       |
| Garnethill Multicultural Centre        | Glasgow           | £329,576  | This grant will allow Garnethill Multicultural Centre to own the building in the centre of Glasgow which it has occupied since 1988 and to carry out repairs that will allow it to continue providing social, welfare and educational support to the local community.   |
| Getting Better Together Ltd            | North Lanarkshire | £42,965   | The group will buy the Springhill Community Centre and nearby land to continue and expand the services.   |
| Gifford Community Land Company         | East Lothian      | £291,520  | The group will purchase a 55.8 acres of woodland next to the village of Gifford, East Lothian.  |
| Glenboig Development Trust             | North Lanarkshire | £87,064   | This group will purchase the building they currently operate and develop it into a 'Life Centre', a flexible, multi-use space that will consolidate a range of community services and facilities into a single community owned asset serving people living in Glenboig, Gartcosh and surrounding villages.  |

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| Glenfarg Village Hall                                     | Perth & Kinross     | £229,140 | The group will purchase the former Schoolhouse adjacent to the village hall, to create an informal meeting space, café and smaller meeting rooms in the building, as well as creating a passage into the village hall.                       |
| Glengarry Community Woodlands                             | Highland            | £25,189  | This group will purchase 3.11 acres of the Drynachan site, a field adjacent to Glengarry Woodlands as an amenity area for the community to hold events, activities and to have better access to the woodland area.                           |
| Glentrool & Bargrennan Community Trust                    | Dumfries & Galloway | £40,000  | The group will turn Glentrool Primary into a multi-use community facility with a self-catering unit for disabled visitors.   |
| Glentrool & Bargrennan Community Trust                    | Dumfries & Galloway | £110,000 | This group will purchase and renovate 3 houses to ensure the continued availability of houses for affordable rent in this rural and remote community.  |
| Glen Urquhart and Strathglass Rural Community Association | Highland            | £88,225  | This group will purchase the local tourist information office and develop it to include a baggage transfer service for tourists and to create a green transport hub, including EV charging points and e-bike hire for the local community.   |
| Go Golspie  | Highland            | £147,890 | This group will purchase the Fountain Road Church Hall in Golspie to continue operating the venue as a multi-use community space.  |
| Gorebridge Community Cares SCIO                           | Midlothian          | £226,000 | This group will purchase a former police station building in the former mining town of Gorebridge, Midlothian from Police Scotland.  |
| Greater Pollok Enterprise Trust                           | Glasgow             | £332,000 | This group will purchase The Wedge on Barrhead Road in order to create co-working spaces for social enterprises and, at Museum Business Park, a hub, including working spaces and business units, to promote the employment of local people. |
| Greener Kirkcaldy   | Fife                | £202,800 | Kirkcaldy town centre to house the Kirkcaldy Community Food Hub offering a range of training, employment, work experience and volunteering opportunities around food production and preparation.   |

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| Grimsay Community Association          | Eilean Siar     | £164,900 | The group will purchase the former Grimsay Free Church Mission House. The adjacent former Church is already in community ownership, thanks to a previous Scottish Land Fund grant, and has been converted into a busy community centre. This new grant will reunite an historic site and provide new opportunities for the people of Grimsay. |
| Helensburgh Community Hall Ltd         | Argyll and Bute | £159,936 | This group will purchase the town's Red Cross hall in order to continue delivering services, including a food bank.   |
| Helensburgh Community Woodlands Group  | Argyll and Bute | £117,128 | This group will purchase the two-hectare Castle Woods in the town in order to improve the woodlands and provide public access.  |
| Helmsdale & District Development Trust | Highland        | £21,000  | The group will purchase a disused filling station and forecourt in the centre of the remote rural village of Helmsdale, East Sutherland and develop it as a community-owned fuel filling station.   |
| Huntly & District Development Trust    | Highland        | £56,500  | This group will purchase the former Royal Bank of Scotland building in the town's main square in order to develop it as affordable accommodation for small businesses and start-up companies.   |
