"Wait... how on earth did you get a climbing wall down that drive?!"

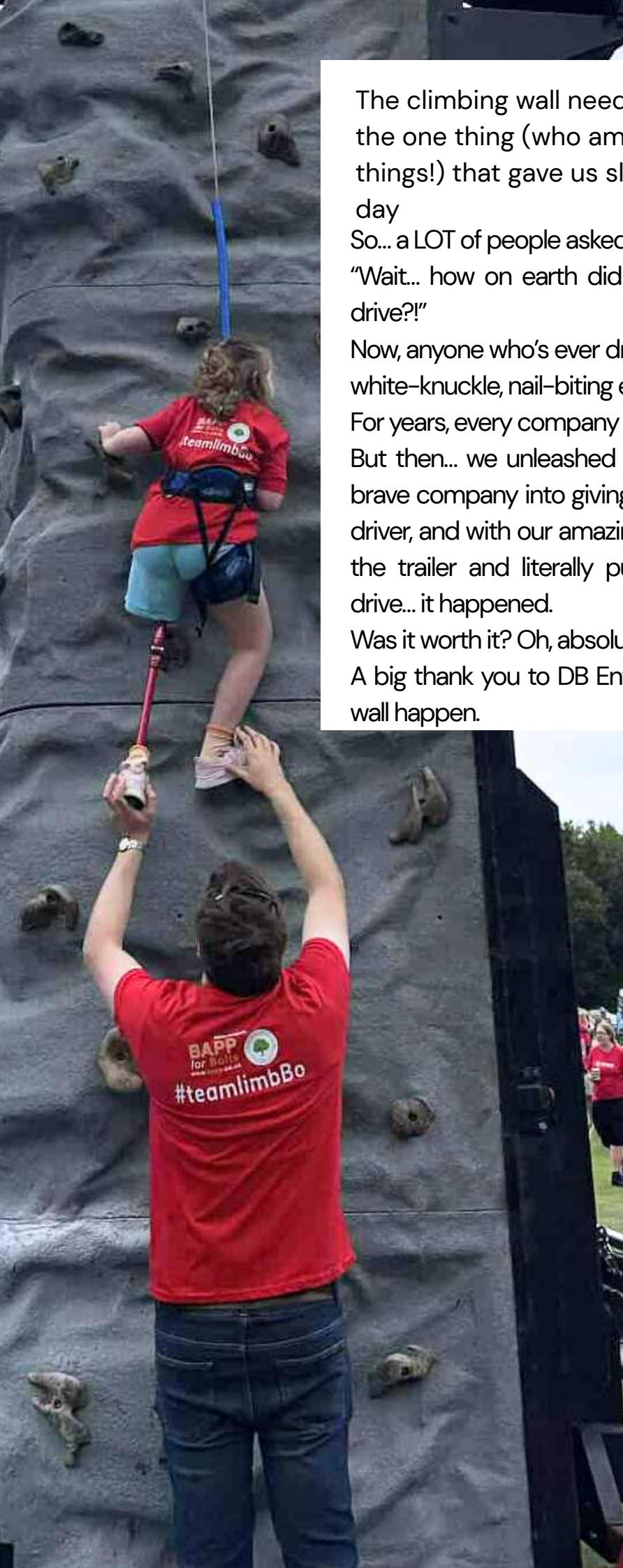
Now, anyone who's ever driven to Car Park One will know—it's a white-knuckle, nail-biting experience just getting in .

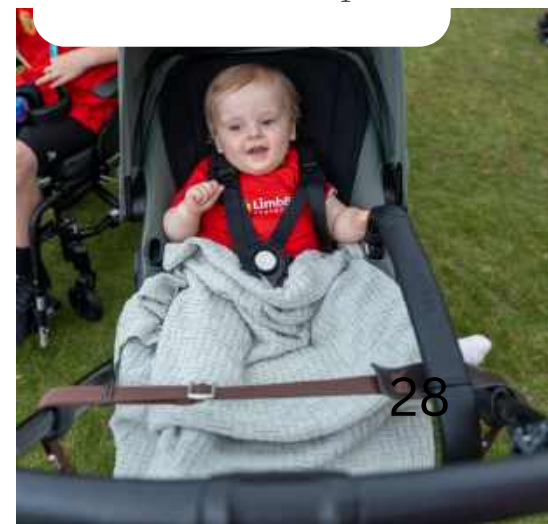




TEAM LIMBBO
