Touch of Love Outreach	Aberdeen City	£60,000	This group will provide activities that will be a mix of educational, social and recreational to two groups that will meet weekly, an eight -11 years and an 11-16 years club.
Oi Musica CIC	City of Edinburgh	£77,394	The organisation will provide free learner-led beginner, improver and advanced music sessions for local children and young people aged nine -19 years which will consist of taster sessions, trombone, trumpet, clarinet, saxophone and drumming skills culminating in a programme of performances.
Space @ The Broomhouse Hub	City of Edinburgh	£95,213	This group will use funding to continue delivery of their programme of skills and training opportunities for young people in South West Edinburgh, helping to prepare them for employment, education or volunteering.
Ochil Youths Community Improvement	Clackmannanshire	£97,067	The group will use the funding to deliver a social action project aimed at young people in the Hillfoots Villages of Clackmannanshire. A steering group of young people will design activities around themes that are important to them such as climate change, bullying, and racism.
Wasp Community Club	Clackmannanshire	£49,800	The group will use the funding to establish a peer led youth club aimed at young people aged 12-17 years and living in Alloa. The project will promote socialisation and improve physical and mental wellbeing through a range of activities including sports and creative arts.
Art Angel (Scotland) Limited	Dundee City	£98,820	The group will use the funding to run a project of drama, art and creative workshops for young people moving from child to adult psychiatry services, helping them to manage the transition and keep good mental health.
Ayrshire Film Company Community Interest Company	East Ayrshire	£85,970	This group will use the funding to develop the media skills of young people from all over Ayrshire in preparation for working in the creative industries.
Voluntary Action East Renfrewshire SCIO	East Renfrewshire	£90,428	This group will use the funding to improve the experience and outcomes of young volunteers in East Renfrewshire by providing an enhanced volunteer programme, which will provide individual support, a preparation for volunteering programme and a volunteer matching service for young people aged 12 to 25 years.
Central Carers Association Falkirk And Clackmannan	Falkirk	£90,725	This project will ensure that the voices and experiences of young carers and young adult carers shape services at local and national levels. A Young Carers Involvement worker will deliver support with young people to build their confidence and skills.

ANDO GLASO SCIO	Glasgow City	£100,000	This group will use the funding to establish a creative hub to work with Roma young people in Glasgow to celebrate their culture and heritage through music and dance, and to continue providing support, opportunities and training to enable the young people to transition into work.
Fire & Peace Recovery	Glasgow City	£41,732	The group will use the funding to deliver a programme of camping trips and outdoor activities for young people in the Drumchapel area of Glasgow.
The Play Center Glasgow CIC	Glasgow City	£33,000	The group will deliver employability, skills-building, and leadership programmes to young people in the Drumchapel area of Glasgow.
Connecting Carers	Highland	£99,000	This group will use the funding to improve the physical and emotional wellbeing of children and Young Carers by addressing the impact of adverse childhood experiences associated with caregiving responsibilities. The project focuses on providing community-based activities, counselling support, and fostering positive family relationships. The project will also support Young Carers in schools by raising awareness, and organising peer support groups.
Growing2gether	Highland	£90,000	This group will use this funding to provide opportunities to build skills through ongoing activities, such as training and a summer event to bring young people together.
Greenock Morton Community Trust Limited	Inverclyde	£82,615	This organisation will use this funding to deliver two free weekly Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths (STEM) workshops throughout Inverclyde. They will also support young people in creating Inverclyde's first STEM festival and encourage young people to become STEM Ambassadors.
Go Kids Performing Arts Scotland	North Lanarkshire	£85,077	This group will provide young people aged 14-25 years with the support needed to manage their mental health and to develop skills to help them cope with trauma. The young people will participate in weekly performing arts activities and monthly peer led sessions exploring subjects including bereavement, suicide and addictions.
Make and Create Arts	North Lanarkshire	£69,918	This group will use the funding to continue delivery of a creative arts programme for young people in North Lanarkshire. The project will support the wellbeing of young people through confidence building, whilst also allowing them to explore further skills development opportunities for a career in the creative industries.
The Scottish Crannog Centre Trust	Perth and Kinross	£85,179	This project will use the funding to build up their pilot project to continue to deliver placements for young people with additional support needs in the Highland Perthshire area.
Create Paisley SCIO	Renfrewshire	£91,063	This group will use the funding to expand and develop their arts based drop-in programme. The group use creative activities as a way to engage young people in informal youth work support, promoting positive mental health and emotional wellbeing amongst participants.
Get Active Coaching CIC	Renfrewshire	£96,000	This group will use the funding to improve access to sport and physical activity, by building a network of community-based, multi-sports clubs across Renfrewshire.
